The rapid immunochromatographic assay (Gram-Tek Rapid) has been found to be very rapid (20-30 minutes), specific, sensitive, easy to perform, and effective in screening for the presence of TB. The present study was undertaken to assess the efficacy of this assay in patients with presumptive TB. In total, 1514 smear-positive patients with suspected pulmonary TB were included in the study. Smear-negative patients were excluded. A sputum sample from each patient was used to assess the sensitivity, specificity, predictive values, positive and negative likelihood ratios of the Gram-Tek Rapid assay in the diagnosis of TB in this group of patients. In patients with smear-positive TB, the sensitivity of the assay for the detection of TB was 100%, the specificity was 90.1%, the positive likelihood ratio was 9.4, the negative likelihood ratio was 0.04 and the positive predictive value was 76%. In patients with smear-negative TB, the sensitivity of the assay for the detection of TB was 69.1%, the specificity was 99.3%, the positive likelihood ratio was 85.9, the negative likelihood ratio was 0.37 and the positive predictive value was 52%. The results of this study indicate that the Gram-Tek Rapid assay is a very rapid and reliable test, and is particularly useful for screening of patients with suspected pulmonary TB.
